U.S. wind power capacity to top 100 gigawatts in 2018

U.S. wind power is on track to cross a major threshold next year, topping 100 gigawatts of electric generation capacity.

In its new monthly forecast, the U.S. Energy Information Administration said it expects the amount of wind power generation capacity installed this year to increase 8% and then rise almost 16% next year to 102 gigawatts accounting for 9% of U.S. electric generation capacity.
