

Appendix B. Data and methodology changes

For 1960 forward, SEDS publishes CO2 emissions data in more detail from individual petroleum products consumption by state and sector for: aviation gasoline, jet fuel, kerosene, residual fuel oil, hydrocarbon gas liquids (HGL), distillate fuel oil, motor gasoline, asphalt and road oil, lubricants, petroleum coke, and other petroleum products.

Previously, EIA included these more detailed data series as unpublished components of the published total petroleum CO2 emissions by state. SEDS expanded these data to be published sooner and in more detail than previous publications.
