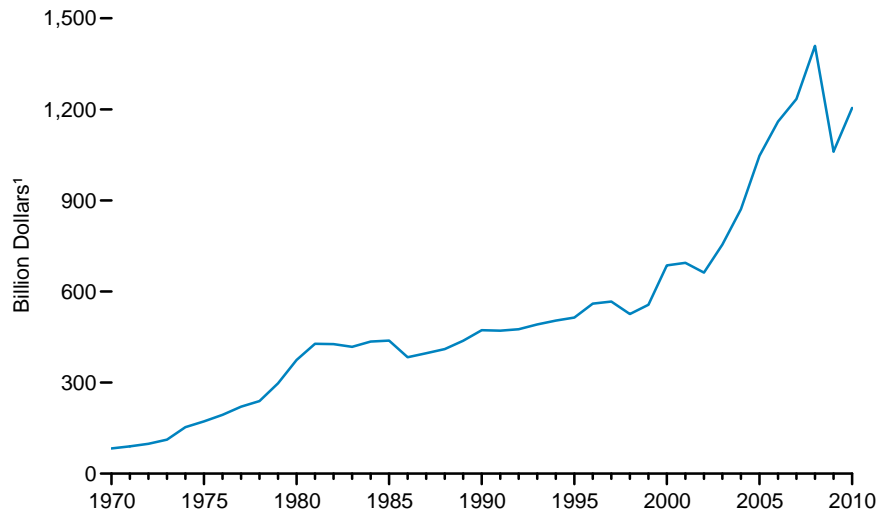
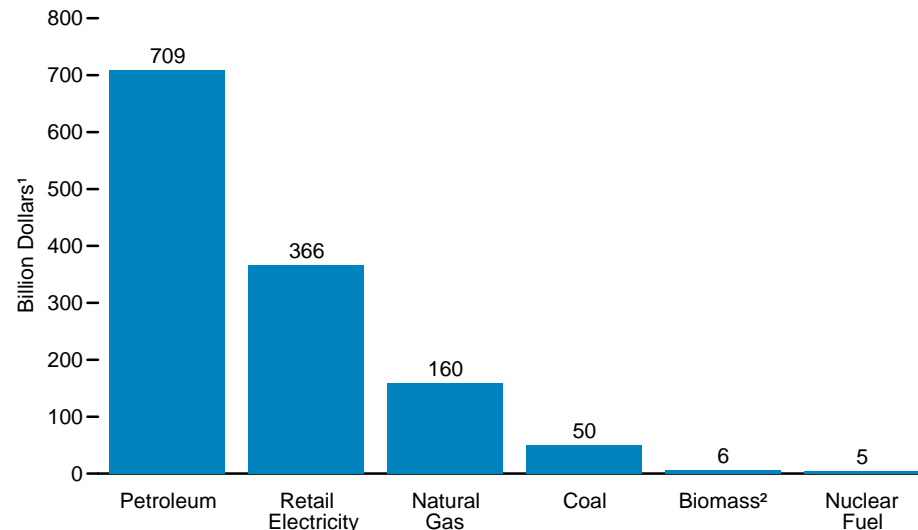


**Figure 3.5 Consumer Expenditure Estimates for Energy by Source**

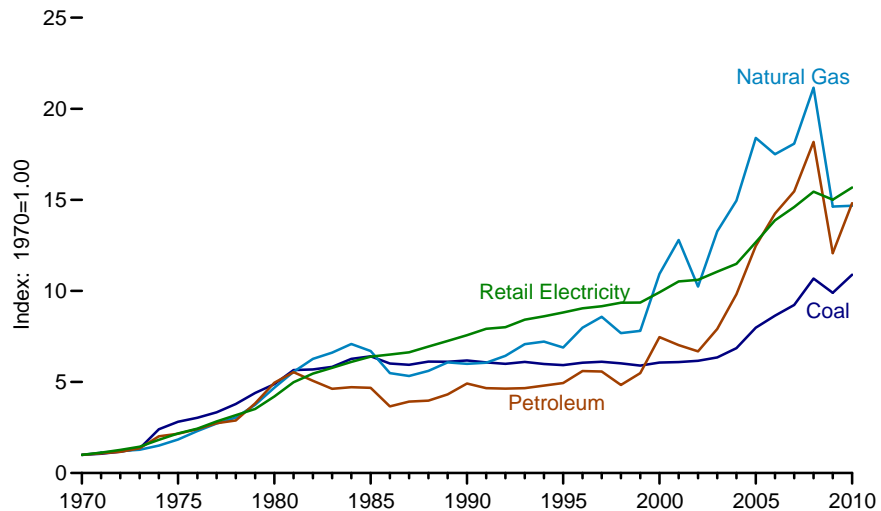
**Total Energy, 1970-2010**



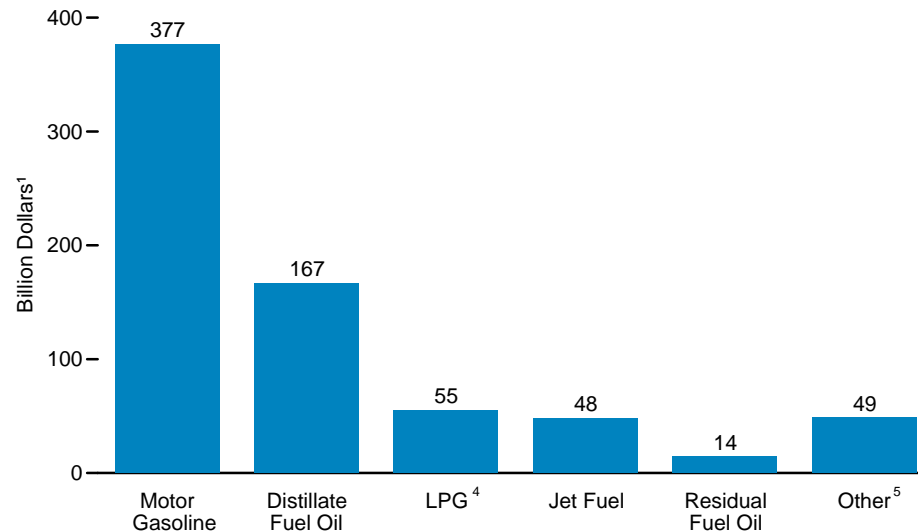
**By Energy Type, 2010**
